However most plans cover only a portion of the dental fee, therefore as a courtesy to our patients will file your primary insurance for you but we ask that you pay the deductible and the portion we estimate your plan will not cover at the time of service. If your insurance company has not paid within 60 days you will be billed for the unpaid balance and payment in full will be expected at this time. We recommend you become directly involved in communication with your insurance company in order to expedite payment.

Appointments
